

Basic steps for registration in the Austrian power market



1) Registration at APCS

First of all a Balance Group has to be registered at the Austrian Balance Group Coordinator (APCS Power Clearing and Settlement).

2) Data Sheet from APCS to APG

After that, APCS will send a data sheet with your basic claims data to APG so that APG can start the APG registration (Austrian Power Grid AG).

3) Registration at APG

The requirements for registration concerning APG are:

- execution of a data-test for sending external schedules

- signing of two contracts for data transmission

4) Green Card, contracts with APG and authorization

When all the necessary requirements are fulfilled with APCS and APG a

“Green Card” is issued by APCS.

The Green Card and the signed data transmission contracts from APG are necessary to request an official authorization from the Regulator (e-control).

This authorisation entitles to represent the Balance Group as a Balance Group Responsible in the Control Area of Austria (respectively the Control Area APG).
